Highlights from NWSAR's May 16th 2019 Meeting Minutes

NWSAR Committee Motions:

- 19-05-004:** That NWSAR approve Administration to meet with Dene Tha' First Nation and CPAWS representatives in Edmonton for more information on the intent of the Bistcho IPCA.
- 19-05-005:** That NWSAR authorize Administration to book a tradeshow booth at the Trappers Rendezvous in Teepee Creek with up-to four NWSAR members in attendance, further including all travel and subsistence expenses paid by NWSAR.
- 19-05-008:** That NWSAR extends Associate Membership to the District of Chetwynd and the Peace River Regional District.
- 19-05-011:** That Administration send letters for NWSAR to meet with the Minister of Alberta Environment and Parks and the Minister of Alberta Agriculture and Forestry, including both Deputy Ministers and MLAs.

Other Relevant Updates:

- NWSAR's presentation at the North Central Local Government Association AGM in Williams Lake was very well received - **Video footage will be available and shared soon!**
- Alberta's United Conservative Party's (UCP) election platform committed to immediately establishing a Provincial Caribou Task Force with municipalities, industry, Indigenous Nations, scientists and the NWSAR Committee! - **NWSAR will request a meeting with Ministers to discuss our role as part of this task force.**
- Dene Tha' First Nation and the Canadian Parks and Wilderness Society (CPAWS) have released a project description for their proposed Bistcho Indigenous Protection and Conserved Area (IPCA) - they are willing to discuss the intent and purpose of this project with all interested parties. 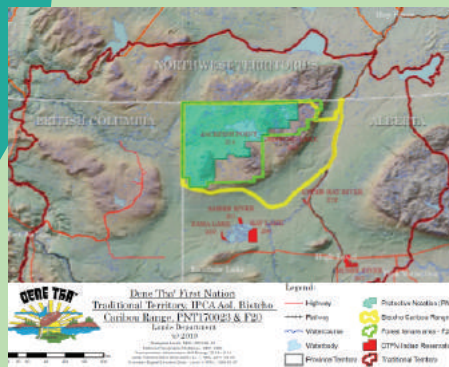
